By Metro:

The National Building Museum is located across the street from Judiciary Square station on Metro's red line. Alternatively, take the yellow or green lines to Gallery Place/Chinatown. Use the Galleries/Arena exit to F Street; at the top of the last escalator (F Street), turn left and walk a short 2 blocks to the Museum. Visit www.wmata.com for more station information.

Parking:

Motorcoach/bus parking is available on a first-come, first-served basis at the G Street entrance. Motorcoaches may park in the driveway (no idling laws), but the driver must be available to move the bus in case of an emergency. Metered parking is available on F, G, and 5th Streets. A parking garage is available at G and 6th Streets at the Verizon Center. An open parking lot is available at H and 6th Streets in Chinatown

Metered parking is located on 5th, F, and G Streets. Nearby parking lots/garages are located on F Street between 6th and 7th Streets, D Street between 8th and 9th Streets, and at the corner of 7th and H Streets.

Accessibility:

Wheelchair and stroller access is located at the G Street entrance. If you are in need of a wheelchair upon arrival, during normal business hours, please visit the Information Desk, as the Museum has wheelchairs available. Exhibition spaces and public facilities are accessible by elevator.

Lunch:

There are no formal lunch facilities at the Museum; however, children may eat in the Great Hall when space is available. There are many inexpensive dining options within walking distance from the museum.

Note for 10:00 AM Ticket-Holders:

The F Street entrance will open at 9:45 AM for 10:00 AM ticket holders only. The building will open at 10:00 AM for all other visitors and ticket holders.
