### MAKE YOUR OWN INSTRUMENT

#### **Materials:**

- 2 study paper plates
- Staples
- Paint and stickers for decoration
- A long paint stick
- Glue
- A few beads
- Rubber bands





- 1. Stack the two paper plates together and ask an adult to staple them together for durability.
- 2. Paint and decorate your paper plate with stickers to add some personality.
- 3. Glue a paint stick to the back of the plates.
- 4. Glue some beads on the end of the paint stick to be your pegs.
- 5. Add some strings by stretching rubber bands around the stacked plates.
- 6. You're ready to rock out!
